

HCCS Student Phone & Device Policy CELL PHONE PLAN

To help our students stay focused, safe, and connected to learning—not their screens— Hellenic Classical Charter Schools (Park Slope & Staten Island) will follow the new NYS law that limits internet-enabled device use during the school day.

Here's what you need to know:



Students may not use personal "internet enabled devices" (like smartphones, smart watches, tablets, etc.) on school grounds from the start to the end of the school day—this includes all class time, lunch, recess, and hallway transitions.



Students may only use their personal internet-enabled devices during school hours if:

- It's part of an approved educational activity.
- They have an emergency, medical need, or where such use is included in the student's IEP, or 504 Plan.
- They use it for language translation or family responsibilities (with permission).
- Where required by law.



All internet-enabled devices must be:

- Locked in a school-provided pouch
- Kept off and stored in school lockers (not on the student) and not used from the start to the end of
 the school day. [FYI NYSED guidance provides as follows: Schools may utilize lockers as a
 dedicated storage method, though to be in compliance with the law, policies must be crafted to
 effectively prohibit the unsanctioned use of covered devices across the entire school day. Allowing
 continuous and unsupervised student access to covered devices when stored in a locker would not
 meet the law's objective of prohibiting unsanctioned use across the school day and school grounds.]



Need to Reach Your Child?

Please call the school's main office. Students may not use their internet-enabled devices phones during the day to call or text home.

What Happens If Students Break the Rules?

- 1st Time: Warning and family contact
- 2nd Time: Phone taken—only a parent can pick it up
- Ongoing Issues: Further consequences to be determined case by case
